We anticipate a full Eagles Nest for our Pre-K 3 section this year, and **we will do our best to accommodate each family who would like to join our school family.**

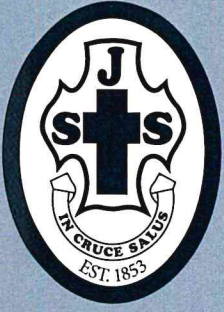
Registration for the 2018-2109 school year is **February 21-March 2**. To be considered registered, the online registration form must be completed, and the registration fee (\$200), the building and maintenance fee (\$150) and student insurance fees (\$12) must be paid. We are not able to accept online payments at this time, so please be sure to send a payment to the school office after completing the online forms. In addition, a list of the records that need to be submitted for new students can be found on our website, [www.stjohnschool.org](http://www.stjohnschool.org), under Admissions.

Students are accepted according to the following priority order: 1<sup>st</sup> priority – current St. John students in good academic, disciplinary, and financial standing; 2<sup>nd</sup> priority – sibling of current St. John students or recent graduates in good standing or children of current St. John faculty; 3<sup>rd</sup> priority – children of St. John Alumni; 4<sup>th</sup> priority – children of other Catholic school alumni who are contributing member of Interparochial church parishes; 5<sup>th</sup> priority – children of contributing members of Interparochial church parishes.

**Only students who are registered by March 2 will be considered in the first round of the admissions process, regardless of priority classification. Any student who registers after March 2 will be placed on a waiting list.**

In the event that there are more students in a priority classification than there are spots available, other factors that may be considered are both parents being alumni, alumni grandparents, membership in support organizations, service to the school, contributions to the capital campaign and other financial contributions.

Families will be notified if they have been accepted or added to a waiting list on March 16. In previous years, this additional

time between registration and notifying families has given us an opportunity to review student records and work with families on the placement options that were best for their children, and we look forward to that opportunity again this year.

This year, we will also be introducing a new fee schedule for Pre-K3 families that includes a tuition credit program. Tuition for Pre-K will be approximately \$50 more per month than other elementary grades. When families enroll their children in kindergarten and first grade here at St. John, they will receive a tuition credit of \$50 per month. A full Tuition and Fees Payment Schedule our Pre K Tuition Credit Policy is attached.
